

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER
40188 GEORGE ROD (WEST DEAN PARISH) FOREST OF DEAN DISTRICT ORDER 2024

WHEREAS Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") being the Traffic Authority for part of the 40108 George Road from outside the property known as 'Bream View' to outside the property known as 'Pinecrest' for a distance of approximately 50 metres ("the Road") is satisfied that use of the Road should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near it.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its relevant powers under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Except for pedestrian access to properties, no person shall proceed nor cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the Road;
2. Nothing in Article 1 above shall render it unlawful for a vehicle being used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes to proceed along the Road;
3. Nothing in Article 1 above shall render it unlawful for a vehicle being used by a statutory undertaker responding to an emergency situation to proceed along the Road;
4. The Road falls within the Parish of West Dean in the Forest of Dean District within the County of Gloucestershire;
5. This Order shall come into operation on the 3rd day of July Two Thousand and Twenty Four and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works have been completed whichever is earlier;
6. This Order may be cited as "Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Traffic Order 40188 George Road (West Dean Parish) Forest Of Dean District Order 2024".
7. In the event of any inconsistency or ambiguity between the content of this Temporary Order and any existing permanent/experimental Order(s) imposing restriction(s) on the Road or diversion routes the latter will be suspended for the duration of the works and the provisions of this Temporary Order shall prevail during that period.
