We want to let you know about the Retaining wall & Parapet reconstruction works taking place in Upper Road, Yorkley(Beddis Cottage). Our aim is to keep you informed and minimise inconvenience wherever possible.

This type of work is weather sensitive, meaning the schedule may need to change at short notice. Conditions such as heavy rain, snow, temperature changes, or unexpected technical issues can affect progress. Whilst we will do everything we can to ensure these works go ahead as planned, we appreciate your patience and understanding if they need to be rescheduled.

Access: This is a 24/7 closure therefore vehicular access will not be possible. A signed diversion route (where applicable) will be in place to help you plan your journey. Emergency blue light services access will be maintained. Pedestrian access will be maintained where possible.

Parking:

To allow the team to work safely, parking will be prohibited on the sections of road marked in red on the map. Unfortunately, any vehicles left in this area will need to be moved.
