

SCHOOL AWARD SCHEME

The Basil Whittington Awards



(Open to all Yr 7 -11 children)

West Dean Parish Council are happy to award individuals who show they have made a difference in their community, school, college, their family or have shown improvement in their personal life.

These awards are not for academic or sporting success, they are for those who make a difference.

The maximum award monies available in any one year will be £500.

The maximum prize per person will be £100.00

A maximum of 3 prizes will be awarded per institution.

The school or community will nominate individuals to West Dean Parish Council who meet the award criteria, giving an indication as to how the award will be spent.

Candidates can only be nominated on one occasion, unless there are exceptional circumstances.

The selection panel will consist of three WDPC Councillors, who have no connection or interests with the school, community group or individual nominated. The panel will select the winners of the awards from the submissions received.

These awards are only applicable to individuals who are educated at any child from yrs 7 – 11 at schools within the parish boundary

The nominations should be submitted to the Parish Council by 30th April in any year.

The award panel will decide upon the allocation of monies to individuals by 30th June in any one year.

West Dean Parish Council may wish to present the awards at a school function or other locations deemed suitable.

Awards made by West Dean Parish Council under this scheme are final.
